# *Winter Field Day*

OH-KY-IN's Winter Field Day event is fast approaching! Once again we'll be using the barn at Harvest Home Park in Cheviot. Although perhaps not quite as majestic as the scene pictured to the left, this has been a great site for us several times in the past and works very well for this event. Mark your calendars for Saturday January 28<sup>th</sup> and Sunday January 29<sup>th</sup> and plan on joining us! Setup will begin on Saturday sometime between 10:30 AM and noon.

We aim for a more experimental approach to Winter Field Day (as compared to the summer ARRL Field Day event). Have a radio you want help with? Bring it! Want to try a new antenna? Let's try it!

We held a planning meeting on October 18th and decided on a few things. Much will remain the same as previous years, but we are making a few changes. First, we plan on handling the food a bit different this year. Although we greatly enjoyed Chef John's chili in the past, the impact of unpredictable weather for this event makes it very hard to estimate expected turnout far enough in advance to purchase and prepare the right quantity. To simplify things, we'll be offering a couple of different options this year instead. For dinner on Saturday, participants may either opt to bring food potluck-style or chip in for a food run (similar to the Wild Mike's run at the summer event). There is an outstanding Italian restaurant (Giovanni's Family Italian) right across the street from the park and would be this author's recommendation. Additional food options may also be provided if needed, but that will be a day-of decision.

For Sunday morning, Ryan AC8UJ will plan on bringing donuts again this year and Rocky KE8DZS has volunteered to provide a hot breakfast casserole of some sort. We will of course have hot coffee available.

## *WIRES-X is Live!*

WIRES-X is now operational on the 146.625 and 146.925 repeaters. Currently the .625 is running in analog mode and the .925 is running in digital mode. You may continue to use the repeaters as usual, but you may also now take advantage of the WIRES-X connectivity. Anyone with DTMF capability can use WIRES-X on the .625, since it is in analog mode. You will need a C4FM WIRES-X capable radio to use WIRES-X on the .925.

Additional details and training will be presented at the January meeting, so if you are curious about WIRES-X, be sure to join us in person or virtually for the January meeting. We still have a bit of work to do on the .625 and it will likely switch to digital operation in the future. Also worth noting is that the .625's CTCSS transmission should once again be working.
